# A Gift in memory


Celebrate the life of your loved one by giving a gift to Chestnut Tree House in their memory.

A gift in memory is a way of honouring the life of someone special while making a difference to the lives of others. A lasting tribute, your gift will help us to continue providing vital care and support to local children with life-shortening conditions.

Our specialist services are provided free of charge to children and their families from across East and West Sussex and South-East Hampshire. It costs over £3.5 million a year to provide our care services both at the hospice and in families' own homes, so every gift in memory is a valued contribution.

Remembering someone who has died is a very personal thing so we offer a range of different ways to give a gift in memory.

## Ask for donations at a funeral or special occasion

Our specially printed envelopes, available on request, can be given to friends and relatives to make their own donation. These can be used at a funeral or to mark a special occasion such as a birthday or anniversary.



## Give in lieu of flowers

Families often ask for donations to Chestnut Tree House instead of flowers at the funeral of a loved one. The phrase 'in lieu of flowers' doesn't necessarily mean that there will be no flowers at the funeral; often it means that the family may have decided to limit floral tributes to immediate family only and others are invited to make a donation to a named charity if they wish.

There are a variety of ways in which people can make gifts in memory at a funeral. Your funeral director will be able to advise you on the different options.





## Create a JustGiving In Memory page

A JustGiving In Memory page is a simple way to honour the memory of someone special. You can create a page in their memory in a few minutes and add your own photos and their story.

JustGiving is an easy and secure way for friends and family to leave messages and donate in memory of a loved one.

You can raise money through your JustGiving In Memory page in a way that suits you. For example, collecting donations instead of flowers at the funeral, inviting friends round for a coffee morning, doing a skydive or celebrating the life of a loved one by making a donation on their birthday or anniversary.

## Set up a Tribute Fund

An online Tribute Fund is an inspiring way to honour the memory of someone special. Your Tribute Fund will have its own individually named web page, which acts as a central place where you can share memories in the form of stories, photographs, messages, music and videos. It's easy for your friends and family to add their tributes and make a secure donation, wherever they are and whenever they choose. Together you can make a real difference in memory of your loved one.

You can raise money for your Tribute Fund in any way that suits you, for example by holding a cake sale, running a marathon, hosting an event or making a donation on a significant date, such as a birthday or anniversary.


## Take part in an event
