

Children's Christmas Card Competition 2017

Do you want to draw a Snowman?

RULES

Eligibility

1. The competition is open to children aged 4-12 years resident in Brighton & Hove, East Sussex, West Sussex and South East Hampshire
2. Contestants must submit their artwork for consideration into the appropriate age category. The competition categories are:
 - a. Children aged 4-8
 - b. Children aged 9-12If you do not enter your date of birth, we cannot judge your work
3. Only one entry will be accepted per child
4. Contestants must supply full submission details as required and comply with all rules to be eligible for the prizes
5. Entries must include the consent from their parents or guardians to participate in the competition

Submission

1. Entrants must provide the following details written clearly on an entry form and/or on the back of the artwork submitted: child's name, child's date of birth, address, parent/guardian's name, email address and telephone number
2. To enter the competition, contestants must submit original artwork of their own creation in A4 format, featuring a snowman, snowmen or a snowman scene
3. Entries should not include glitter or collages as this makes them very difficult to reproduce
4. No photographs, sculptures, or other artwork will be eligible for submission
5. Unfortunately artwork submitted for the competition will not be returned at the end of the competition

The competition

1. The competition will run from 19 October 2017 – 24 November 2017
2. The closing date for entries is Friday 24 November 2017
3. All entries received by this date will be entered into the judging
4. Winners will be judged on their work by a judging panel
5. The judging panel's decision is final in every situation and no correspondence will be entered into
6. The winners will be notified in early December and invited to accept their prizes at Chestnut Tree House on the afternoon of Thursday 14 December 2017
7. The competition organisers reserve the right to cancel the competition at any stage, if deemed necessary in their opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of their control

Prizes

1. There will be one winner per age category. Only the winners will be contacted personally
2. The winners will be invited to visit Chestnut Tree House on the afternoon of Thursday 14 December 2017 to accept their prizes
3. Prizes must be taken as stated and cannot be deferred or substituted
4. There will be no cash alternatives

Intellectual Property

1. All copyright in the artwork submitted by the entrant will be the intellectual property of the entrant
2. The entrant shall grant to Chestnut Tree House for the purpose of display, publication and any future use in book, calendar or electronic format an exclusive irrevocable perpetual royalty-free licence to use the copyright in their sole discretion and without any payment by Chestnut Tree House
3. Your data will only be used in conjunction with this Christmas card competition
4. The competition organisers will not pass on contestants' personal details to any other organisation except for the purposes of running the competition which they have entered
