## How will the £50 Challenge help Chestnut Tree House?

Chestnut Tree House provides specialist palliative care to over 300 children and young people with life-shortening illnesses across East and West Sussex and South East Hampshire. We care for the whole family, offering psychological support, respite care and sibling support, end of life care and support following bereavement.

It costs over £3.5 million each year to provide all our care services, both at the hospice and out in the community in families' own homes. We receive less than 7% from central government funding so rely heavily on the support of the local community and activities like Chestnut's £50 Challenge in order to continue providing this vital care to local sick children and their families.
